"Holiday Ribbon Wreath"

It's never too early for the holidays - Join us

on September 1st HSFAG Secretary, Ednah Folk will bring the holidays to us. Utilizing a few materials, you will be able to make your own ribbon wreath during the meeting with Ednah's expert instructions (supply list is available below).

Ednah has enjoyed making ribbon wreaths when she learned it from a former HSFAG member. Around the holidays, she she can be found covered in glitter from making wreaths. When she is not making ribbon wreaths or trees, she can be found making ribbon lei, attempting to sew or making things to try to use up her (ahem!) *modest* collection of supplies.



Materials Needed:

- 14" Straw wreath (available at Ben Franklin or Flora-Dec). Any size is acceptable, but the 14" size is a good size for hanging on door.
- (approx. 100) 1.75" Greening pins or floral pins (for a 14" straw wreath) 
- (2) ROLLS of different colors of WIRED ribbon* (any width from 1.25-2.5"). One color will be used for the bow and the other one will be used for the wreath itself. You will need at least 25 yds of wired ribbon for the entire wreath. (50 yd rolls are available at Sam's Club, Costco, Ben Franklin and Flora-Dec)
- #22 or #24 floral wire 
- Wire cutter
- Scissors (not your good ones as we need to cut through wire).

* Note: If you are using 1.5" ribbon to cover a 14" wreath, get (2) rolls instead of one.



Attendees should prep their ribbon by cutting it into 12" sections and folding the corners down (make a dog ear of no more than 1/8") of each ribbon. Approximately 25-30 yards will be needed for making a 14" wreath. Folding down the corners of the ribbon will prevent the wire ends from getting pulled out of the ribbon or catching onto other ribbons, your finger, etc.
