workshop by Carrie Johnson

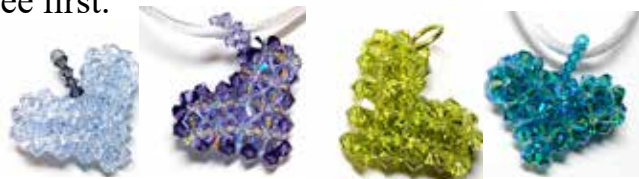
Join us on February 5th and make your Valentine's Day sparkle. Carrie Johnson will be teaching us how to make a Swarovski Puffy Heart. This cute little heart can be used as a pendant, phone charm, purse charm or even an ornament. No needles required for this little bundle of love. But, please bring those bead mats, glasses/magnifiers and lights. Carrie will have kits for \$9-11 which feature Swarovski crystal available in an assortment of colors. If you wish to bring your own, crystals, they must be bicone shape (like a diamond) and 4mm. The Swarovski bead style for this is 5328 4mm.



Supplies: Bead Mat, Glasses/Magnifiers, Light, Small Scissors, and Skinny Sewing Needle, Kit OR Swarovski 5328 4mm Bicones – 80 in one color. Optional: Swarovski 5328 3mm for bail – 10 in matching color or darker than the 4mm. Carrie will supply the following: Stringing Material, 6mm Round Beads, Seed Beads and other Bail Options to include Charm Findings. Kits in assorted Swarovski colors will be available for purchase.



Note: A fellow fiber artist is looking for your used Hawaiian coffee bags. If you drink coffee that is any Hawaii brand (i.e. Lion, Hawaiian Isles, etc.) please bring in your empty bags – you do not need to rinse or clean them, just make sure you use all the coffee first.
