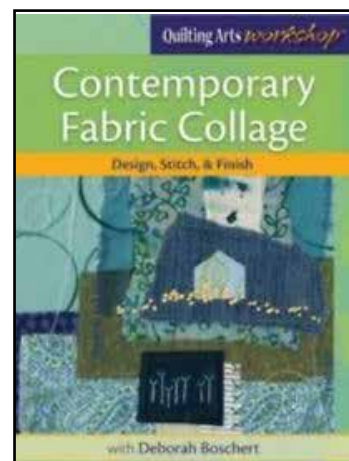

"Contemporary Fabric Collage" A VIDEO FEATURING DEBORAH BOSCHERT

Join fiber artist Deborah Boschert as she shares her approach to fabric collage using a variety of materials, including sheers and other unexpected fabrics, as well as free-motion work and hand-stitched details. Deborah imparts design strategies, and she guides viewers through the process of selecting an inspiring collection of fabrics.

This video was made in 2012 and is 66 minutes long. After viewing the video, attendees will have a chance to stamp on fabric as Deborah Boschert demonstrates in her YOUTUBE video.
